Established Bus Routes

- ✓ Set Routes established by BRTA throughout Adams, Cheshire, Dalton, Great Barrington, Hinsdale, Lanesborough, Lee, Lenox, North Adams, Pittsfield, Stockbridge, and Williamstown
- ✓ At this time, New Ashford will not have an established stop on the route between Pittsfield and Williamstown. We will use the BRTA Flag Service and Paratransit Transportation by Appointment Service.

Flag Service

- ✓ A location for hailing a bus as it goes by ON AN ESTABLISHED BUS ROUTE i.e. between Pittsfield and Williamstown.
- ✓ The BRTA bus can stop, anywhere that is safe, along the route both northbound & southbound on Route 7.

Paratransit Transportation by Appointment

- ✓ An ADA (Americans with Disabilities) reservation system for individuals with a mobility impairment. Some restrictions apply. Contact BRTA at 413-499-2782 or 800-292-2782 for additional information.
- ✓ An “origin to destination, and back” level of service
- ✓ When accompanying an approved passenger, their Personal Care Assistant (PCA) rides for free.
- ✓ Requires an approved application with BRTA (by passenger and PCA name)
- ✓ ADA: Service days and hours of service are the same as Established Route Services.

Days and Hours of Service

- ✓ Bus Service Days and hours- varies by route
 - 5:45 AM to 7:20 PM Weekdays
 - 7:15 AM to 7 PM Saturday
 - No Service on Sunday and Major Holidays

Fares

- ✓ Fares vary for the different services. Contact BRTA at 413-499-2782 or 800-292-2782 for additional information.
- ✓ Reduced rates are available for seniors 60 years and older.

Charlie Card

- ✓ Charlie Card (Prepaid discounted Smart Card for a Flag or Established Route) Card can be loaded on bus if adult full fare, 60+ riders must go to Pittsfield to load card to receive the Senior Discount.
