- 1. Approve Minutes August 3: On a motion by Mark, seconded by Ken, the minutes from the 8-3-2020 New Ashford Select Board/MLP Meeting were approved.

- 3. Road Commissioner: Keith took care of a tree down on Greylock Road. He has the mower and will do the sides of the road this week. We will pay \$600 to Dalton for its use. Keith will check to see if there are any leftover millings from the Route 7 paving project. Rumble strips will be installed on select areas of Route 7. Mark talked with Dave Reynolds about the problem with merging where the climbing lane ends at the intersection of Mallery Road and Old Route 7. Keith will check with the pavers for Smith Road about when they will start work.
- 4. Unforeseen Business: Select Board meetings will be held on a day other than Mondays during the fall, due to a scheduling conflict.

Ken will write the Emergency Management Director position for Frank Speth. We received an overdue invoice from Condron. That invoice is being paid for from the Mohawk Trails Woodland Partnership Grant. Ken will confirm it was submitted and Lori will monitor the bank account for the grant fund receipt.
